Find and copy a phrase that shows mother's shock.

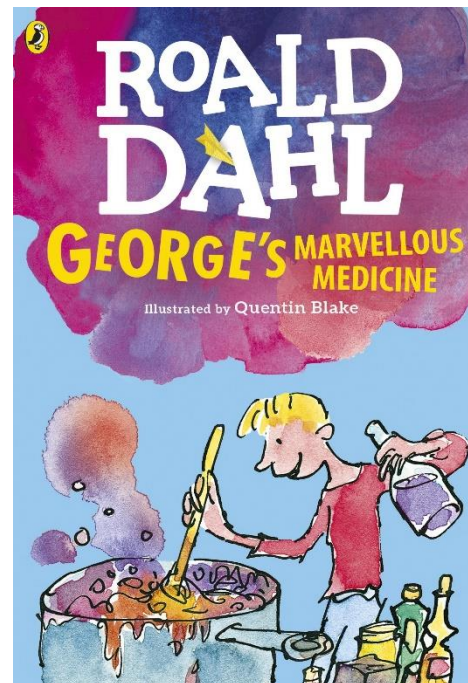
What problem might present itself when remaking the marvellous medicine?
