- 3. Singing nursery rhymes and action songs building to singing and playing Wind The Bobbin Up Rock-a-bye Baby Five Little Monkeys Jumping On The Bed Twinkle Twinkle
- If You're Happy And You Know It Head, Shoulders, Knees And Toes
- 4. Share and Perform
