Find and copy a word that means the same as 'jealous'.

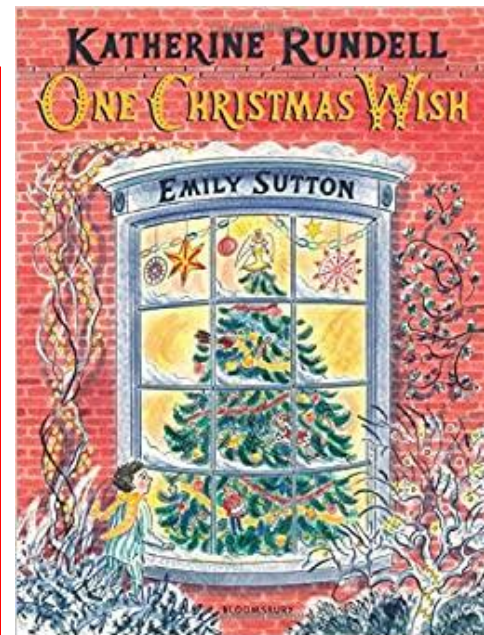
Who do you think Arthur is?
