1. What I am good at?	I can identify something I am good at and understand that everyone is good at different things		What are you good at doing and why? Are we all good at/like the same things?
2. I'm Special, I'm Me!	I understand that being different makes us all special.	Jigsaw Jenie tells the children something s/he is good at. Ask the children to talk to each other and find out something that they are each good at,	Is it OK to be and do different things to the people around us? Does it matter if your friend likes something you don't? Is it OK to wear different clothes?
3. Families	I know we are all different but the same in some ways.	As a group, look at how the photos have been sorted. Is there a different way we could sort the photos?	Can we group people easily? Are we all the same/different? How?
4. Houses and Homes	I can tell you why I think my home is special to me.	Look at the houses you have made. Are they the same or are they different? Show children pictures of different styles of house from around the world.	Are any similar to where they live or are they different? What would a house look like? Are all houses the same?
5. Making Friends	I can tell you how to be a kind friend.	Read one of the suggested stories or one similar about making friends.	Did the story do any of the children's ideas about how to make friends? Was there anything in the story that the children hadn't talked about? How do you make friends? How can we be kind friends? What can we do if we see someone by themselves? How can we be kind friends? What can we say that would make us a kind friend?
6. Standing Up for Yourself	I know which words to use to stand up for myself when someone says or does something unkind.	Does Jigsaw Jenie like what s/he sees? Talk with friends about what they didn't like in that scenario and then feed back to the circle.	Do you like what you see? How does it make you feel? Is it OK to say unkind things and why? How does it make the children feel seeing that unkind behaviour? How do you think the puppet/grown-up feels?
