Key Skills:

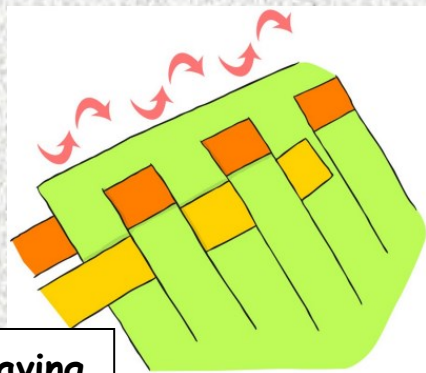
- Sort different textiles by different properties e.g. colour/size
