Key Grammar:

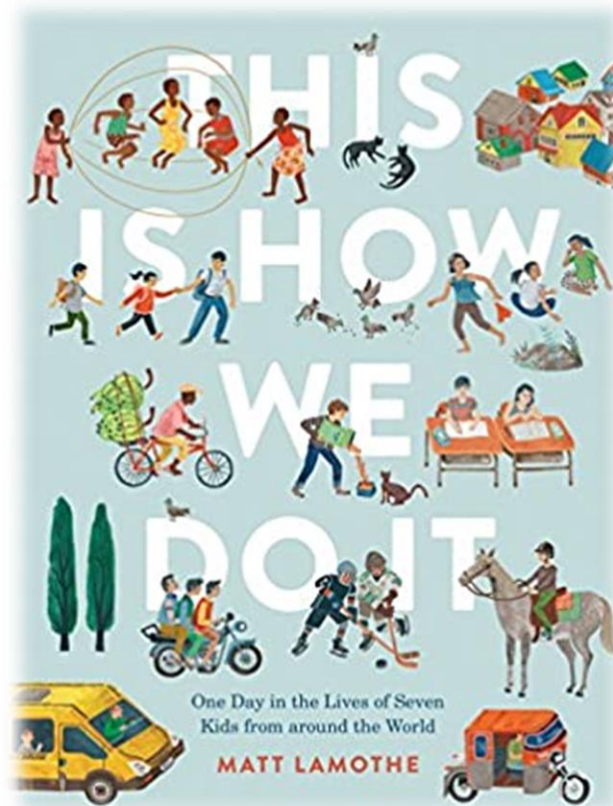
