Key Vocabulary:

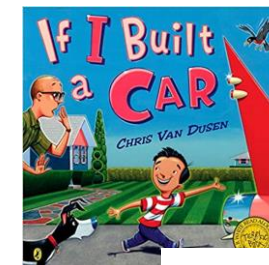
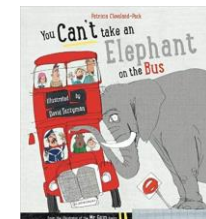
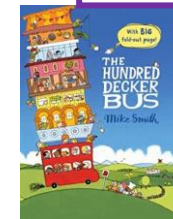
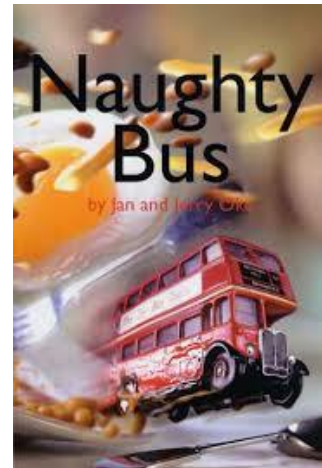
