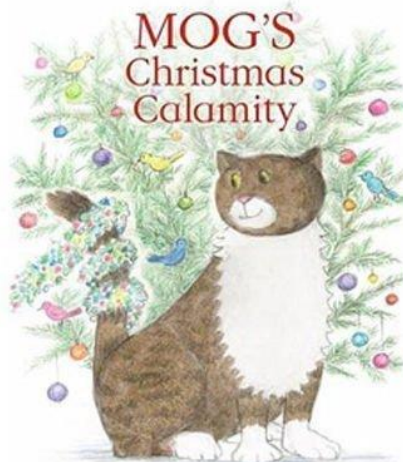




Mog's Christmas Calamity
